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CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Research Background

Discourse is a language context that exists in a conversation or communication interaction. Discourse is spoken (spoken) or known as spoken text. Oral discourse is the delivery of discourse through oral or direct media. This type of discourse requires high listening power so that the interaction in its delivery is not interrupted. CHAPTER II

REVIEW OF LITERATURE

A. Theoretical Framework

1. Moral Value

a. Moral Value

William James Earle states that in contemporary English, the words *moral* and *ethical* derive from the Greek *ethos* means usage, character, personal disposition or tendency. *Morality* and *moral* derive from the latin *mores*, meaning customs, manner, and character (Earle, 1994). As stated by *Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary*, moral relates to the standard or principles of good behaviour (Hornby, 2010,p.959).

According to Stenberg (1994), morality is concern with good or right in people relationship with each other. It is to be specific about definitions of good (or bad) and right (or wrong), since the terms can be used in several different ways. Social relationship can be judged by standards such as efficiency or showing careful when makes judgements and decisions (Stenberg, 1994, p.938). Henry Hazlitt asserts that morality is an art to maximize happiness because by considering this matter it will be useful for our self and the other people (Hazlitt, 2003).

Moral values are the result of a valuing process of comprehension implementing of God and humanity values in life. So, these values will guide human knowledge and creativity appropriately (Linda and Eyre, 1997).

Moral value has always been a perennial aim of education. Moral education is whatever schools do to influence how students think, feel, and act regarding issues of right and wrong. The function of school, it has been believed that not only to make people smart but also to make them good. The return of moral education to the limelight is attributable to the fact that modern societies increasingly have to deal with disturbing trends both within schools, and in the wider society.

b. Moral

Moral is deciding good or bad considered behavior. A morality is sacrifice from little goodness to big goodness (Hazlitt, 2003). Morality according to Bentham is art to maximize happiness; it can be seen by achieving the existence of happy and joyful life of all people (Hazlitt, 2003,p.109).

The opinion also clarified Sigelman (1995 p.330) into 3 components of morality:

1. An *effective*, or emotional components, consisting of feeling (guilt concern for other feeling and so on) that surround right wrong action and that motivate moral thoughts and actions.

2. A *cognitive* component, centering on the way we conceptualize right and wrong and make a decision about how to behave.
3. A *behavioral* component, reflecting how we actually behave when. For example, we experience the temptation to cheat or are called upon to help a needy person.
4. The moral in the literature is the message or lesson to be learned from the story of event. Moral is a term the Latin language support, namely *mos* and in the plural *mores* which also means custom or way of life a person by doing good deeds (decency) and avoid evils (Ruslan, 2004, p.102). Moral concerns something that is good and bad in human change in their life. Hornby, (2011,p.285), also says moral values are values concerning principles of right and wrong and the standards of behavior. Moral in literary works usually reflects the views of the author's life, views on the values of truth.

c. Value

Values are closely related to attitude, value are our beliefs about how we should behave and about some final goal that may or may not be worth attaining. According to Richard (2001) values can be divided into two types: (1) instrumental values, which guide people's day to day behavior, and (2) terminal values, final goals that are or are not worth attaining. Instrumental and terminal values are easier to distinguish; values that guide day to day behavior

are similar to those that are learned in scouting organizations, loyalty, honesty, optimism, unity, self-respect, courage and helpfulness.

Meanwhile, values are any characteristic deemed important because of physiological, social, moral or aesthetic consideration, and then values can be clarified values as follows; values cultural, values hierarchy, value moral and spiritual, and value social (Carter 1959).

1. Cultural values: value being a function of interest, the value of the arts is cultural if one's interest is primarily in refining his taste and developing his power.
2. Hierarchy value: of a ranking of values of objective in education according to some principle or order in which the objective are so arranged that below lead to and from a part of those above all taken together present the aims of philosophy of education under consideration.
3. Moral and spiritual value: those principle and standard, which is accepted by the individual and applied in human behavior, exact life and bring it into accord with approved levels of conduct, this principles, from the point of view of naturalist, approach universality in their concept and acceptance by all mankind.
4. Social aspect of human interaction value: that is regarded as being worthy, important, or significant for the proper functioning of group life.

Lombardo (2004) also explains that values are the ideals or standards that people use to direct their behavior, values are what people strive to realize in their lives. Value are the standard we use in right or wrong in human behavior. We judge ourselves and other in terms of our values. We may not agree with another person's values, but everyone lives by values everyone makes judgements about what is important in life through their values. (Lombardo, 2004).

Moral value has always been a perennial aim of education. Moral in education is whatever school do to influence how students think, feel, and act regarding issues of right and wrong. The function of school, it was believed, was not only to make people smart but also to make them good. The return of moral education to the limelight is attributable to the fact that modern societies increasingly have to deal with disturbing trends both within schools, and in the wider society.

2. Types of Moral Value

According to Linda and Richard Eyre (1993) there are three types of value. They are individual moral value, social moral value and educational moral value. All of them have each types of moral value, they are as following.

2.1 Individual Moral Value

Individual moral value begun with the development of quality or an attitude within ourselves that determines how we behave and how we treat of others.

The moral value of individual, It includes:

a. Honesty

Honesty is estimable character; fairness and straight forwardness of conduct or adherence to the fact. Honesty is freedom from subterfuge or duplicity, truthfulness, and sincerity

b. Bravery/courage

Courage is the synonym of bravery, bravery is face(something involving possible unfortunate or disastrous consequences) or endure (as hardship) use with self-control and mastery of fear and often with a particular objective in view. Bravery is able to meet danger or endure pain or hardship without giving in to fear. Linda (1993) bravery is arising from or suggestive of mastery of fear and intelligent use of faculties especially under duress. Or courage means doing the right thing when it's hard (and even if it means being called a —chicken).

c. Peace ability

Calmness and peace ability are values because they help others as well as ourselves to feel better and to function better. In addition to social values, they are contagious qualities. As you develop them within

yourself, they are —caught by others around you. Peace ability means understanding, calmness, patience, control and accommodation — essentially to opposite of anger, losing one's temper and impenitence.

d. Self Reliance (Confidence) and potential

There are two separate but closely related principles involved here. The first is the self-reliance of accepting the responsibility for and the consequences of one's own actions and performance, rather than blaming luck or circumstances or someone else. The second is the finding of our full abilities by trying to be one's best self and asking the best from oneself the conscious pursuit of individuality potential and the conscious rejection of avoidable mediocrity. Self-reliance and potential, as we have called it, is a powerful value. Those who have it help others by accepting responsibility and doing their best in the world. Those who don't have it hurt others by blaming them and by failing to develop the gifts and talents that could serve or enlighten or benefit other people. One who reaches his potential helps others in many ways as he develops himself. One who never seeks his full potential indirectly hurts others by not doing the good or setting the example he is capable of. This value is about trying to know ourselves, to do our best, and to accept the consequences both of who we are and of what we do. One way to think of self-reliance and potential is as two sides of the same coin. Self reliance has a lot to do with taking the

blame or the responsibility for negative things that happen. Potential has a lot to do with taking a little credit and taking the right kind of pride in what we are able to become and what we are able to accomplish. When we take blame and responsibility, we resolve and grow and improve. When we don't we become bitter, jealous, and defensive. When we take positive pride in what we're doing with ourselves and our gifts, we feel the growth of individuality and self-esteem. When we don't, we tend to become followers of plodders in the standard ruts of life.

e. Self-discipline and moderation

Self-discipline means many things: being able to motivate and manage yourself and your time, being able to control yourself and your temper, being able to control your appetites (and here the companion word moderation comes into play). Self-discipline and moderation are two sides of the same coin. Self-discipline is pulling up and away from the laziness of doing too little. Moderation is pulling in and away from the excesses of trying to do or to have too much. Discipline and moderation are profound and universal values because their presence helps us and others and their absence inevitably causes short- or long-term hurt.

f. Purity and pureness

Awareness to keep the value of chastity before and after marriage. Understanding the role of marriage and sexuality life in it. Awareness

about the consequences of long term (and extended) that can be caused by immoral sexual life (Linda, 1997, p.82).

g. Hard work

Work hard is, behavior that indicates serious efforts to overcome various resistance such learning and assignments, as well as much as you complete your task. Work hard is the key to become success.

h. Justice (Fair)

Justice is something we should all be prepared to accept — for justice will always come, in some form, sooner or later. It is the law of the harvest and of cause and effect. Cause and effect are two sides of one fact. every secret is told, every crime is punished. Every virtue is rewarded, every wrong is redressed, silence and certainly cause and effect, means and ends, seed and fruit, cannot be severed, for the effect already blooms in the cause, the end pre- exists in the means, the fruit in the seed. After about justice, turn to mercy. Explain that while we should accept justice, we should try to give mercy. Do not be interested in making others pay for their mistakes. Do not hold grudges or carry a chip on your shoulder. These tendencies make us vindictive and vengeful and cause us to poison ourselves and our outlook.

2.2 Social Moral Value

Social moral value associated with man's relationship with another human being in society. In doing relationship, the human need to understand the norms in force in order to do can go smoothly or not there is a misunderstanding. Human being are supposed to be able to distinguish between good deeds and bad in the relationship with other human beings. The moral value of social, it includes:

a. Loyalty (Trustworthy)

Loyalty is loyal manner. Loyalsness is the quality, state, or an instance of being loyal; fidelity or tenacious adherence. Loyal is faithful and the devoted to a private person; faithful or tenacious in adherence to s cause, ideal, practice or custom. Loyalty to family, to employers, to country, church, school, and other organization in which commitments are made.Support, service, contribution, reliability and consistency in doing what you say you will do.

b. Respect

Respect is the basis and foundation (and often the motivation) for several of the other basic values of life. Children who learn both to implement and to understand the principle of respect will be better members of society, better friends, and better leaders. Respect to other people is also important, but respect is not only in terms of attitude and said words that occur due to hard training. True respect is seriously concerned about the feelings of others.

c. Love and affection

Love is full affection for. Love is a communications code word for the letter. Love is full referent adoration for (God). Loving to themselves is more than just a loyal and respectful. Dear friends, dear to the neighbors who also love to hate us, and emphasizes the lifelong responsibility for saying to the family.

d. Sensitive and Unselfishness

Becoming more extra-centered and less self-centered. Learning to feel with and for others. Empathy, tolerances, brotherhood, sensitivity to need in people and situations.

e. Kind and Friendly

Simple kindness and friendliness is a great human value. It involves parts of several other values, such as the empathy of the value of sensitivity and the boldness of the value of courage, but it is a very separate and different value from these. This value is also partially an extension of the value of peace ability. In peace ability, we try to teach children not to hurt and to avoid conflicts. Here we teach the positive, pro-active side of being a friend, acting friendly and kind, and becoming more polite and courteous. Friendliness and gentleness also apply to self. Children who learn to be gentle and tolerant with themselves grow up to be less stressed and more relaxed and self-secure.

Simple friendliness (based on the earlier established criteria and definition of a value as something that helps others and diminishes hurt in others) is a profound value. Often a simple act of kindness or a word or two of extended friendship can change another person's attitude and mood for the rest of a day - and longer.

2.3 Educational moral value

Educational value is concerned with the development of desirable states of mind in the transmission of what is worthwhile to those who themselves come to care about these valuable things. Cooper (1986:15). states that educational value is the concept of value and rule that leads how to the proper concept of a person, or an understanding that other people count or graphs of other people count or grasp of other people emoticon. Educational value related to develop other aspects: personality, morals and ethics, etc. That has relation to this education. The educational moral value includes:

a. Smart

Smart is a mnemonic acronym, giving criteria to guide in the setting of objectives, for example in project management, employee performance management and personal development. The letters S and M usually mean specific and measurable. Possibly the most common version has the remaining letters referring to achievable, relevant and time bound. However, the terms inventor had a slightly different version and the letters have meant

different things to different authors, as described below. Additional letters have been added by some authors. The first known use of the term occurs in the November 1981 issues of *Management Review* by Gorge T. Dorant “the principal advantage of smart objectives is that they are easier to understand and to know when they have been done”. Smart criteria are commonly associated with Peter Drucker’s management by objective concept.

b. Innovative

Innovative in teaching is necessary for the present and future of education to help students to reach their full potential. Higher education should serve the long term intellectual needs of the students, for example, whether providing new material by teachers helped the students to gain new insight or opened up new channels of intellectual simulation or enhanced student’s essential and creative thinking power. Innovative in teaching is a necessity for all teachers in order to meet the educational needs of the new generations. However, teachers’ competency for innovative teaching is a key factor influencing innovative teaching performance. Some research points out that many teacher lack competencies for innovative teaching.

c. Creative

Robyn (2010) “Creative in education is when students are able to use imagination and critical thinking to create new and meaningful forms of ideas where they can take risk, be independent and flexible”. Instead of

being taught to reiterate what was learned, students learn to develop their ability to find various solutions to a problem. Coming up with various out of the box solution is known as divergent thinking and there is no one way of cultivating this skill largely due to the newness of the concept and the limited scientific information on creativity.

d. Gratitude

Gratitude, thankfulness, thanksgiving, or gratefulness, from the Latin *gratus* meaning thankful is a feeling of appreciation felt by and / or similar positive response shown by the recipient of kindness, gifts, help, favors, or other types of generosity, towards the giver of such gifts. Crumpler (2000) state “the experience of gratitude has historically been a focus of several world religions”. It has also been a topic interest to ancient, medieval and modern philosophers, and continues to engage contemporary western philosophers. The systematic study of gratitude within psychology only began around the year 2000, possibly because psychology traditionally focused more on understanding distress than on understanding positive emotions. The study of gratitude within psychology has focused on the understanding of the short term experience of the emotion of gratitude (state gratitude), individual differences in how frequently people feel gratitude (trait gratitude), and the relationship between these two aspects.

3. Movie and Its Elements

Movie is the telling of stories which are real. Movie usually adapted from a novel, by producer to make a real character of actor and actress. The literary elements of novel and movie is almost same. They are:

1. Character

Character is a participant in the story, and is usually a person, but may be any personal, identity, or entity whose existence originates from a fictional work or performance. Character may be of several types as follow :

- a. Point of view character : the character from whose perspective (theme) the audience experiences the story. This is the character that represents the point of view the audience will empathies, or at the very least, sympathies with. Therefore this is the main character.
- b. Protagonist : the driver of the action of the story and therefore responsible for achieving the stories Objective Story Goal (the surface journey). In western storytelling tradition the protagonist is usually the main character.
- c. Antagonist : the character that stands in opposition to the protagonist.
- d. Supporting character : a character that plays a part in the plot but is not major.
- e. Minor character : a character in a bit/cameo part.

2. Plot

Plot or storyline is the rendering of the events actions of a story. On micro level, plot consists of action and reaction, also referred to as stimulus and response. On a macro level, plot has beginning, middle, and an ending. Plot refers to the series of events arise out of conflict experienced by the main character. The conflict may come from something external, like a dragon or an over bearing mother, or it may stem from an internal issue, such as jealousy, loss of identity, or over confidence. As the character makes choices and tries to resolves the problem, the story's action is shaped and plot is generated. In some stories, the author structures the entire plot chronologically, with the first even followed by the second, third and so on, like beads on a string.

- a. Conflict : the basic tension, predicament, or challenge that propels a story's plot.
- b. Complications : plot event that plunge the protagonist further into conflict.
- c. Rising action : the part of a plot in which the drama intensifies, rising toward the climax.
- d. Climax : the plot's most dramatic and revealing moment, usually the turning point of the story.
- e. Resolution : the part of the plot after the climax, when the drama subsides and the conflict is resolved.

3. Setting

Setting the location and time of a story is its overall context where, when and in what circumstances the action occurs.

There are three kinds of setting:

- a. Setting as place : the physical environment where the story takes places.
The description of the environment often points toward its importance.
- b. Setting as time : includes time in all of its dimensions, determine the importance, ask, “what was going on at that time?”
- c. Setting as cultural context : setting also involves the social circumstances of the time and place. Consider historical events and social and political of the time.

4. Point of View

Point of view is the way in which the author places himself in the story or the way the author tells the story. They are as follow :

1. Point of view

Point of view is simply who is telling the story. Types of point of view:

a. First Person Point of View

First person is used when the main character is telling the story. This is the kind that uses the “I” narrator. As a reader, you can only experience the story through this person’s eyes. So you won’t know

anything about the people or events that this character hasn't personally experienced. First person Peripheral: This is when the narrator is a supporting character in the story, not the main character. It still uses the "I" narrator but since the narrator is not the protagonist, there are events and scenes that will happen to the protagonist that the narrator will not have access to.

b. Second Person Point of View:

Second person point of view is generally only used in instructional writing. It is told from the perspective of "you".

c. Third Person Point of View:

Third person point of view is used when your narrator is not a character in the story. Third person uses the "he/she/it" narrator and it is the most commonly used point of view in writing.

There are 3 main types of Third Person point of view:

a. Third Person Limited

Limited means that the point of views is limited to only one character. This means that the narrator only knows what that character knows. With third person limited you can choose to view the action from right inside the character's head or from

further away, where the narrator has more access to information outside the protagonist's view point.

b. Third Person Multiple

This type is still in the "he/she/it" category, but now the narrator can follow multiple characters in the story. The challenge is making sure that the reader knows when you are switching from one.

c. Third Person Omniscient

This point of view still uses the "he/she/it" narration but now the narrator knows everything. The narrator isn't limited by what one character knows, sort of like the narrator is God. The narrator can know things that others don't, can make comments about what's happening, and can see inside the minds of other characters.

5. Movie

Movie is motion picture includes photographs, picture and audio visual. According to Sharon (2011) "a movie or motion picture includes photographs, diagrams, or pictures in a series which projected in a screen by a projector for process in turning in a screen that cause appearance in screen look natural movement". Movies, also known as films, are a type of visual communication which use moving pictures and sound to tell stories or inform (help people to

learn). Films furthermore presuppose a cinematic space that is both physical and discursive, one where film and spectator, cinema and body encounter one another. Each type of cinema (as well as every film theory) imagines an ideal spectator, which means it postulates a certain relation between the (body of the) spectator and the (properties of the) image on the screen, however much at first sight the highlighted terms are “understanding” and “making sense” “interpretation” and “comprehension”. According to Eisaesser (2010) “what is called classical narrative cinema, for instance, can be defined by the way a given film engages addresses and envelops the spectatorial body”.

5.1 Relation Between Movie and Moral in Education

Movie and education have a very close relationship, because now this movie could become a media that can be used parents to instill the values of life to them. Positive impact of watching a new movie clearly visible at children aged three to five years. Because at this age, their capability to read can be increased by watching a movie. According to Musbikin (2007) “movie can be used as a medium of learning to inculcate good values when parents may be wise to accompany the child when watching the movie if parents know how to use television to watch the movie in order to become a medium of education for their children, so parents can make the movie as a second school for their children who keep it intelligent and moral”. According to Musbikin (2007) “parents should still provide assistance to children when they see the movie, the

parents must in from and give sense to them about behavior that is in the movie”. Establish good communication in your child can reduce the potential negative effects when watching a movie, because the most important education is in a family where the parents are the most responsible towards moral education of their children, because in the family they grow and develop. Allowing children to watch excessive means allowing growth and development and education of troubled children.

5.2 Movie as the Media in Education

Media from the Latin word medium, meaning mediator or deliver. Media is mediator or deliver message from the sender to the receiver message. The medium of education is very important at every level of education and more so during the elementary education as that is the time when a child is exposed to the vast world of knowledge. Sadiman in his book (1993:16-17) said that the functions of media education are as follow:

- a. To make the message not always verbal (not form oral or write)
- b. As problem solving limited room and time.
- c. As problem solving when the children is passive.

The examples of modern media are radio, television, film, and so on. The examples of traditional media are wayang, lenong, ketoprak etc. This media can used as media to communication and education. Mass media has roles in national development as agent of change. Its purpose is to help accelerating the

mindset of society from the traditional to modern because the nature of audiovisual is very effective in attracting the sympathy of society who sees it. It is very communicative in conveying their message, shaping attitude, and changing behavior patterns. Darwanto (2007:32) said that “the main functions of the mass media are the surveillance of the environment in simple terms, the mass media provide information that can’t be reached directly by the public and the correlation of the parts in responding to the environment. Everything that showed by the mass media only displays what are needed and deserved to be broadcasted, and the transmission of the social heritage from the one generation to the next. This function is more directed at the educational function that is conveying social and cultural value.

Movie is one of the many kinds of modern mass media. Using this media we can get many information and education. Movie and education have a relationship because now this movie could become a media that can be used parent to educate. This media can be used as medium of learning. The parents can make the movie as a second school for their children.

Movie as screen educators helps the students perceive, understand and appreciate the unique visual and aural language of film and the role of this language in human communication. By developing skill in response to these visual-aural languages, student can increase their understanding of themselves and others and explore the communicative and artistic potential of film as a

medium of expression. According to Deighton (1971:3) “movie is displayed through electronic media. Message displayed by the electronic media is enlightening, educating, and entertaining so easily understood by all levels of society”. Besides, it also provides the stimulus, suggestion, imagination, and emotion from audiences. According to Darwanto (2007:44-45) “Message contribution will be received more quickly because the nature of audiovisual”. Message from mass media has fundamental strength from non mass media in conveying the message to the general (public). The programs comprise some groups, for example, program for children, adult, family, etc. Student should be motivated by giving several examples, explanation, and guidance, so it will make student easy to imitate the message from the movie. Learning method develops day and day in accordance with technological developments and the need of education through mass media.

Audiovisual will greatly help in the development and needs of children, because education program is published pragmatically, so that, the audience will take some message from the program. The use of audiovisual equipment is intended to show the effectiveness and efficiency of teaching and learning process, so the children are hoped to develop reasoning and imagining power. The results of various researches suggest the use of audio-visual teaching and learning can improve teaching efficiency up to 20%-70% by Darwanto (2007:100). Audiovisual is very helpful in teaching and learning, because with

these tools students can do observations more closely again and through observation will give the impression of depth that will improve memory.

6. Synopsis of Little Mom

“Little Mom” is an Indonesian movie that tells the story of the world of today’s teenagers who cannot be separated from problems. The following is a synopsis of Little Mom, starring Natasha Wilona, Al Ghazali, and Teuku Rassya. Little Mom basically follows the twists and turns of the journey of Naura (Natasha Wilona) dealing with the reality of being pregnant out of wedlock as a teenager and trying to hide her pregnancy. In addition, this movie is also pepped with a love triangle between Naura and Keenan (Al Ghazali) and Yuda (TeukuRassya).

Naura is a 16 year old teenager with an almost perfect life. Not only beautiful, Naura is also known to excel in school and become the pride of her parents. In LittleMom synopsis, Naura is told that she dreams of becoming an obstetrician. Naura’s dream fell apart because she was pregnant at a young age. Naura becomes pregnant due to having sex with Yuda, a popular student and basketball athlete at school. The situation becomes more complicated because Yuda moves to Japan and Naura has to face Keenan, the troublemaker at school. Behind is cold demeanor, Keenan was always there for Naura in difficult times. Naura’s problems are even more complicated because she has to face Celine (ElinaJoerg), Naura’s arch rival in every way, who also likes Keenan. The movie Little Mom is

directed by Guntur Soeharjanto who previously worked on a number of feature films such as Automatic Romance (2008), Purple Love (2011), Pinky Promise (2016), and Ayat-AyatCinta 2 (2017). Meanwhile, the story script was written by Rihem Junianti.

7. Discourse Analysis

Discourse is verbal or written communication between people that goes beyond a single sentence. Importantly, discourse is more than just language. The term “language” can include all forms of linguistic and symbolic units (even things such as road signs), and language studies can focus on the individual meanings conveyed by language in context. “Context” here refers to the social, cultural, political, and historical background of the discourse, and it is important to take this into account to understand underlying meanings expressed through language. A popular way of viewing discourse is verbal or written communication between people that goes beyond a single sentence.

Importantly, discourse is more than just language. The term “language” can include all forms of linguistic and symbolic units (even things such as road signs), and language meaning of words. Discourse goes beyond this and looks at the overall meanings conveyed by language in context. “Context” here refers to the social, cultural, political, and historical background of the discourse, and it is important to take this into account to understand underlying meanings expressed through language.

B. Relevant of Study

There are several research papers regarding to literary study of analyzing the moral value in movie. The writer would like to present other researches that have close relation with this study.

The first research is the study conducted by Aisyah Fatin Kahar (2014), she is an alumny of English Department of Universitas Muhammadiyah Sumatera Utara. She conducted the research under the title “**An Analysis of Moral Values in *Dangerous Minds* Movie**”. In her research, she tried to analyze the moral value in the movie. The method used by the researcher was desriptive qualitative method. The data source of the research was the dialogues, it was taken from the movie “*Dangerous Minds*”. To analyze data, her used content analysis. Then,the result of the study showed that some of moral values in the movie. From the analysis, it can be concluded that there are love and affection, respectful, bravely, kind and friendly, sensitive and not selfish, honesty, hard work, patriotism, and responsibility.

The second was research from Windriani (2016), with graduating paper entitled “**An Analysis Moral Values in *UP* Movie**”. In her research, this movie tells the story of grandfather named Carl Fedriksen who is trying to realize the ideals of his late wife Ellie to go to Paradise Falls. In his plan to bring the house he had built with Ellie to paradise falls. Mr. Carl was accompanied by a scout named Russell who was clean and determined to help Mr.Carl get a badge to help the elderly.

Mr. Carl moved his house using a balloon filled with Helium. They were stranded in a place not far from Paradise Falls and continued their journey. On the way they met with Kevin (a type of poultry with colorful feathers), Dug (a dog that can talk), Charles Muntz (Adventurer famous for his ambitions). This story is colored with many comedies about Russell's funny behavior, and teaches many moral messages, and also the genre of this movie is comedy adventure.

Obviously, There were similarities and differences between this study and previous study. One of them, the previous study about the title of the movie. The similarity between this research and the previous study was focused moral value. In this research the writer took the data from "Little Mom" movie. Additionally, the data in previous study were collected by analyzing the dialogues among characters, but in this study the writer focus on main character in this movie.

C. Conceptual Framework

This study deals with the analysis of moral value in *Little Mom* movie, literary work is an expressions of life such as imagination dreams, wishes and more that appointed from educational phenomena. Expression articulated within literary work is set up with message, that's moral value. *Little Mom* movie is one of them that consist moral value and educational moral value based on reflection of daily life. Moral value in *Little Mom* movie need to be learned and applied in life especially in the school so that the students and teacher can applied value in daily life especially in education. The explanation simply be illustrated in a figure of conceptual frame work below :




Figure 2. 1 Conceptual Framework

CHAPTER III

METHOD OF RESEARCH

A. Research Design

This research was applied descriptive qualitative research by using content analyzing research design and the data consist of dialogs. It aimed to analyze the moral value in *Little Mom* movie. Qualitative research seek to understand a phenomenon by focusing on the total picture rather than breaking it down into variables. The purpose is a holistic picture and depth of understanding rather than a numeric analysis of data, and also qualitative study involves analysis of data such as words, examples transcript, video, pictures, recordings, notes, documents, the products and records materials.

The source of the data were taken from the script of *Little Mom* movie which by directed Rihem Junianti on the Iflix and WeTV. The purpose of this research is to explain the types of moral values that exist in *Little Mom* movie. To classify data and to determine the types of moral values using Linda and Richard Eyre theory there are three types of value, they are individual moral value, social moral value and educational moral value.

Futhermore, the technique for collecting data documentary technique. The steps of data collecting are follows : downloaded the movie, watched and read the whole movie and transcript of movie, identifying the work sheet the cases of moral value

and the types of moral value, and then select the dialog text from the movie for the analysis.

There were some steps to analyze qualitative research according to Miles and Huberman (2012) that are: data reduction, data display, and conclusion and verification.

B. The Source of Data

The source of the data were taken from the script of *Little Mom* movie which directed by Rihem Junianti on the Iflix and WeTV.

C. Techniques of Collecting Data

In collecting the data for analyzing this research, the writer gathered the references that support the subject matter of the data and apply some steps. The technique for collecting data is conducted to get information which needed to support the goals of research. The technique for collecting data is documentary technique. The steps of data collecting are as follows :

1. Downloaded the movie of *Little Mom* on Iflix or We TV.
2. Watched and read the whole movie and transcript of movie, pay attention in every dialogue or the pictures screen play to find out the moral value in the *Little Mom* movie.
3. Identifying the work sheet the cases of moral value and the types of moral value.

4. Select the dialog text from the movie for the analysis. The selection will be taken consecutive and selected for is needed in the analysis.

D. Techniques of Data Analysis

There were some steps to analyze qualitative research according to Miles and Huberman (2012) :

1. Data Reduction

Data reduction referred to the process of selecting, focusing, simplifying, abstracting, and transforming the data that appear in written up field notes or transcriptions. The mass of data has to be organized and some how meaningfully reduced or reconfigured. These data were condensed so as to make them more manageable. In this case, the researcher sorts the data by focusing on the classifications of moral value dialog between characters on the moral value in *Little Mom* movie. The researcher focuses on the script or dialogue which contain of the classifications of *Little Mom* movie.

2. Data Display

The researcher was displayed the research data by using the table and grouping to analyze the data. The researcher to extrapolated from the data enough to begin to identify systematic patterns and interrelationships. The researcher drew the data after describing, the data continuously and throughout in the course of the study as the outcome. The researcher analyzed the data and explain it that

have been taken and then makes conclusion. The outcome of the study was description and analyzing the researcher sorts the data by focusing on of moral value in the movie.

3. Conclusion and verification

After the data were displayed and interpreting then the researcher drew conclusion. The conclusion was made clearly in order to make the readers easier to know the result of the study.

CHAPTER IV

DATA AND DATA ANALYSIS

A. Data Collection

As mentioned the previous above, the data in this research was a movie entitled “Little Mom” by Rihem Junianti. This research is focused on analyzing data on the types of moral values of each character. Based on the data that has been collected, there are 42 data based on the moral values and after analyzing moral values found 14 types of moral values, namely: the types is honesty, bravery, peace ability, confidence, self-discipline, pureness, hard work, respect, love and affection, sensitive and unselfishness, friendly, smart,creative, and gratitude.

B. Data Analysis

In this chapter, the topic analysis is explored in depth through the dialogues of the characters in the “Little Mom” movie, which contains many moral values. The main goal is to find the kinds of moral values and moral values contained in the “Little Mom” movie.

After analyzing the data. The research answers the formulation of this research problem that has been previously described. To determine the moral values contained in the “Little Mom” movie and the types of moral values contained in the “Little Mom” movie

1. What are types of moral values in Little Mom movie?

Researcher analyzed the data in this research, based on the types of moral values contained in the “Little Mom” movie, based on the theory previously described. There are various types of moral values that are applied in human life. Then researcher only pays attention to dialogue in the script that contain moral values, so that the researcher found the moral values contained in the “Little Mom” movie.

A. Individual Moral Value

- 1) **Honesty**

According to Yuda, Keenan and Naura. Honesty is the most important thing in life. Believe that with honesty will come good things in life. The theory is relevant to the following dialogue.

Data 1

Naura : Am I your grilfriend?

Yuda : *You are my grilfriend* (after announcing his relationship with school friends) **Eps 1 scene minutes (0:27:58)**

Analyzed what the data means:

The crowd CHEERS

The dialogue above shows the moral value “Honesty” when Yuda is bullied by other women, Yuda always respects Naura as his partner.

Data 2

Naura who is scared because Yuda’s parents are going to Japan and Naura is afraid that Yuda will go with her parents.

Naura : Soon your parents will go to Japan. Are you going with them?

Yuda : *Oh my gosh Naura, I won't* **Eps 2 scene minutes (0:12:33)**

Analyzed what the data means :

Yuda who is convincing Naura with his talk.

Yuda tries to be honest with Naura that he will not go with his parents to Japan, and will not leave her.

Data 3

Naura who is in her anger

Naura : What do you think? Your biggest fear?

Yuda : *Yes, I can get kicked out of basketball and also I'm afraid of my parents,* Naura. **Eps 6 Scene Minutes (0:15:36)**

Analyzed what the data means :

Trying to be honest with his partner Naura, even though it hurts his partner. Because honesty is more important in a relationship.

Data 4

Naura who is trying to be honest about her feelings for Keenan, so that Keenan doesn't expect more

Naura : *Keenan, sorry I don't have any feelings for you. My feelings for you are just friend* **Eps 7 Scene minutes (0:09:51)**

Keenan : Just friend. I know that

Keenan tries to stay fine.

Analyzed what the data means :

The dialogue above illustrates the value of “Honesty” in any case. And these values are the main ones in living life and in socializing. As bitter as it is, honesty will still be said because with honesty good things will come in life.

2) Bravery

According to Keenan and Naura, “Bravery” in taking any action while on the right path is a must that must be applied within oneself to protect oneself or others. Because with “Bravery” can defend anyone who is right, and to become a protector for yourself when under threat. Example of the moral value of bravery is as follows:

Data 5

Keenan really doesn't accept seeing his friend being bullied with other students

Keenan : *You're the master here?* (protect his bullied friend) **Eps 1 Scene minutes (0:21:08)**

Friend : Fall silent

Analyzed what the data means :

Everyone has the right to live in peace about their shortcomings, it doesn't mean that when someone has flaws, then others treat them arbitrarily with bad things.

Data 6

Naura tries to maintain her pride when called lowly

Naura : *Which is more flawed? A woman who is pregnant out of wedlock or a man who impregnates a woman out of wedlock and then leaves the woman?*

Eps 3 Scene minutes (0:47:17)

Analyzed what the data means :

The dialogue above describes the bravery in oneself when under threat, either verbally or physically. Men or women have the right to defend themselves when something is threatening them.

3) Peace Ability

According to Naura, Yuda, Kiki, and Papah Keenan, making “Peace Ability” is very important when doing wrong to someone, making peace will make the atmosphere better and there is no pent up grudge. Because being able to make peace with situations and people will make yourself much calmer.

When Naura was caught pregnant by her mother, Naura apologized to her mother while crying

Naura : *Naura, Sorry mah (found pregnant)* **Eps 2 Scene minutes (0:41:16)**

Mamah Naura : Cry

Analyzed what the data means :

Naura who is trying to be at peace with her mother and the situation when her parents found out she was pregnant.

The dialogue above describes the need to make peace with oneself, others and situations. The importance of controlling emotions when at the peak of anger and still respecting others.

4) Confidence

According to Widi, Celine, Naura and Yuda "Confidence" is when you believe in yourself for the opinions you have to convey to the other person to make the other person believe in what is said or done that really happened.

Kiki : Looks like we've won for sure, don't we?

Widi : *Yes, for sure. There's a crush on celine like that. Who is already a professional athlete too! It's really cool.* **Eps 1 Scene minutes (0:06:16)**

Analyzed what the data means :

Believes in the abilities of his friends because he always wins when he attends competitions everywhere

6) Purity and Pureness

According to Naura, Yuda, Ibu Naura “Purity” in marriage is something that must be applied in the life of all couples and marriage is based on love. People who love each other will get the purity that is in marriage

Naura : All four testpacks were positive, Yuda. I'm pregnant **Eps 1 Scene minutes (0:50:52)**

Yuda : This is not possible

CHAPTER V
